Essential Traits: enjoys working with kids (ages 8-13), responsible, positive, optimistic, enthusiastic, engaging, flexible, self-starter, customer service oriented, and lover of the outdoors (during summer).

Responsibilities: Camper safety is our #1 priority! **Assistant Coach** will assist Head Coaches and Camp Director, in: collection of team attendance throughout the work day; supervision, organization, instruction and coaching of teams (parent/guardian drop-off, games and activities, restroom and locker room safety, lunch, bus rides, off-site field trip activities/organization, parent/guardian pick-up); and equipment set-up / clean-up, etc. There will be lots of opportunities to actively engage in team activities/games! However, like any job, some aspects (like escorting campers on frequent trips to/from the restroom) can get a little monotonous -- we still need your undivided attention during these times! As previously stated, you will need to enjoy being around younger kids -- and the youngest campers are those who need the most support, so think about kiddos who just finished 1st-2nd grade. Those who have a tendency to be glued to their phone need not apply!

Hours & Pay: Assistant Coaches will be hired as an Independent Contractor to work full weeks, Monday - Friday, from 9:00 AM - 4:00 PM, and will be paid \$150 per week (up to 6 weeks in 2026), by check on Friday. Independent Contractors are responsible for any/all equipment, taxes, workers' compensation insurance, travel, disability benefits, legal documentation/requirements (if applicable), and any other work expenses. Sandlot Westerville is not liable for lost or damaged personal property.

Applicants must: (1) be at least 14-years-old, (2) a high school or college student, (3) obtain parent/guardian permission to conduct duties stated above and (4) include at least one letter of recommendation from an adult (**non-relative**: teacher, employer, coach, youth group leader, etc.) who knows your character traits to be consistent with those stated above.
