We understand that many post-secondary opportunities (college applications/acceptance, scholarship applications, etc.) necessitate community service hours to be seriously considered as a candidate. We are willing to offer the opportunity to gain that experience while working at our camp for those who exhibit positive character traits and wish to help local kids grow their character as well!

Essential Traits: enjoys working with kids (ages 5-13), responsible, positive, optimistic, enthusiastic, engaging, flexible, self-starter, customer service oriented, and lover of being outdoors during the summer.

Responsibilities: Camper safety is our #1 priority! Volunteers will be expected to assist Head Coaches and Camp Director (licensed teachers), in: collection of team attendance throughout the work day; supervision, organization, instruction and coaching of teams (parent/guardian drop-off, games/activities, restroom and locker room safety, lunch, bus rides, off-site field trip activities and organization, parent/guardian pick-up); and equipment set-up / clean-up, etc. There will be lots of opportunity to actively engage in team activities/games! As previously stated, you will need to enjoy being around younger kids -- and the youngest campers are those who need the most support, so think about kiddos who just finished Kindergarten-2nd grade. Those who have a tendency to be glued to their cell phone need not apply!

Letter of Recommendation: in return for your time spent serving as a volunteer, you will receive a letter of recommendation/confirmation from the Camp Director highlighting your work ethic and hours.
